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



3. STARTING DETAILS

- 3.1. Your Car Number and start time can be found on entry list within these instructions.
- 3.2. All Crews must book in as per schedule on Page 5 and present
 - Their completed, signed Scrutiny Slip
 - And any other information that was not presented at Scrutiny. REMEMBER - NO SLIP NO START
- 3.3. Competitors Briefing will be held at the Rally HQ at 0815 hrs. All Crews (including a Service Crew Member) are required to attend.

4. START LOCATION

4.1. ALL RALLY CARS MUST BE PARKED IN ASSEMBLY LOCATION AS PER THE MAP BELOW BY 0800 hrs.



- 4.2. Rally cars must follow the route indicated in the map and follow officials directions when parking at the start location.
- 4.3. The start location and rally HQ is at Yarra Glen Racecourse. Note a speed limit of 20 km/h in ALL AREAS within the Racecourse area.

5. ROUTE INSTRUCTIONS

Route Instructions and **Recce** information will be issued at book-in after receipt of a completed, signed Scrutiny Slip and completion of Documentation. At the time of collecting your route instructions, we urge you to check the list of Next of Kin contact numbers and Service Crew contact numbers that will be held at the Documentation Desk. Please update these if necessary – these lists are what HQ staff will use to contact people in the event of you having an incident during the rally.

- 7.2. The following items are to be checked:
 - Vehicle's registration papers
 - Log Book, the Driver's civil license
 - Competitor's CAMS Licence
 - CAMS Licences and current CAMS Affiliated Car Club Membership cards of both Crew Members
 - Helmets and Apparel
- 7.3. Competitors not attending official Scrutiny must produce Vehicle's registration papers, Log Book, Driver's civil license, Competitor's CAM License, CAMS License and CAMS Affiliated Car Club Membership cards of both Crew Members at Event Documentation. These Competitors should allow extra time for checking these items at Event Documentation.
- 7.4. Both Crew Members AND the Competitor (if not the same person) must present at either official Scrutiny or Event Documentation to sign the CAMS Disclaimer Form. If either Crew Member is under 18, a parent/guardian must be available to sign the CAMS Disclaimer Form. Service Crew members must sign on at Event Documentation to be covered by CAMS Insurance for the duration of the event.

8. RUNNING DETAILS

- 8.1. First car will start 9.00 am and finish at approximately 4.15 pm.
- 8.2. Late running time for both VRC and VCRS will be 30-min in excess of the Target Time between two Time Controls or a total lateness exceeding 40 minutes at the end of each heat. For VCRS the total lateness will be 40 min to the end of Service at Yarra Glen and then a maximum total of 40 minutes to the Finish.
- 8.3. Crews should note there may not be time to recover cars before the second pass of stages.
- 8.4. If a stranded Crew is passed by the 99 car (VRC) and 999 car (VCRS) the Crew may not continue at speed on a competitive stage. A Crew that has been passed MUST get sign off by the respective course car before rejoining any stages competitively

- 10.1. After special stages **3&8** there is a remote refuel location as per your route instructions. For VRC crews, you will have completed 46.23km of special stage and 47.97km of liaison. After the refuel, VRC crews will have 21.47km of special stage and 27.08km of liaison to Service/Finish. For VCRS Crews, the distance to the refuel is the same as the VRC, but you will have 14.92km of special stage and 32.52km of liaison to Service/Finish. No other servicing is permitted.
- 10.2. Crews participating in the remote refuel, must have a separate fire extinguisher to the one carried in the competing vehicle. This must be next to the car whilst refueling is taking place

11. CONDUCT

- 11.1. Competitors are reminded to conduct themselves appropriately Judges of Fact will report any Misconduct to the Stewards, which will be dealt with accordingly.
- 11.2. Crews found speeding either by Police or by the use of Rallysafe will be referred to the Stewards to have the following penalties applied:
 - Exceeding Quiet Zone or civil speed limits by up to 30 km/h above the relevant limit

1st offence: \$200 fine 2nd offence: 5 minute penalty 3rd offence: Exclusion

Exceeding Quiet Zone or civil speed limits by greater than 30 km/h above the relevant limit:

1st offence: \$200 fine plus 5 minute penalty 2nd offence: Exclusion

11.3. <u>No wheel spin will be allowed at the start of ALL stages for both VRC and VCRS Crews</u>. Any Crew found to be deliberately wheel spinning will have the following applied:

1st offence: 30-sec 2nd offence: 60-sec 3rd offence: Exclusion

11.4. ALL competing Crews will be running at 1 minute intervals. The organisers have allowed enough time for ALL Crews to be at the start of ALL stages with enough time to be organized. ANY CREW THAT FAILS OR DELIBERATELY HOLDS UP THE START LINE will be told to pull aside and will be repositioned 5 car spaces behind the previous start time. This position will be held for the remainder of the rally. NO EXCUSES!

11.5. VCRS Crews are also reminded that the use of pace notes is forbidden. ANY VCRS Crews found to be using any other information other than the supplied road book will be reported to the Stewards and recommended for exclusion from the event. <u>Checks will be conducted.</u>

12. RECONNAISSANCE

- 12.1. Reconnaissance will be conducted as per the schedule. All stages will be open and closed at the same times
- 12.2. Only the Driver and Co-Driver are permitted in their registered reconnaissance car. It is strictly prohibited to have more than the registered Crew in the registered car. Any Crews found to be breaching these rules will be reported to the Stewards, which may result in not starting the event and forfeiting the Entry Fee. Special circumstances can be granted by application to the Clerk of the Course via email before Friday 14th September.
- 12.3. The maximum speed is 60-kph on all competitive stages.
- 12.4. There is a maximum of 2 passes of each stage.
- 12.5. It is the Crews' responsibility to fill out the reconnaissance card if the stage is unmanned and to present the card to Officials when asked.

13. MAPS

Any required map will be supplied by the Organisers.

14. CAR NUMBERS

The Organisers will supply car numbers for Competitors use. There will be 3 small sets of numbers and 1 pair of large numbers. The small numbers are to be placed as follows:

- 1. On service car windscreen
- 2. On the windscreen and 1 on the right rear screen of the competing vehicle
- 3. Large numbers are to be placed on the rear side windows of the competing cars



15. ODOMETER CHECK

The course check vehicle recorded **5.37km** from the location indicated on the map below, returning to the same point using the mapped route in an anti-clockwise direction. Use the left most lanes where available to record an accurate distance. The odometer check start and finish location will be clearly marked by a "H" board.





16. SERVICE AREA

16.1. Please travel in the direction shown on the map supplied in the Service Park. Please park service vehicles in the location assigned to your car number and please remove all rubbish. Please note the location of the re-fuel area. And also park your trailer in trailer parking area.



- 16.2. <u>There is to be no unloading of trailers before 07.30hrs on Sunday 22nd</u> this is to respect the home owners that border the Racecourse. ANY CREWS to be found to be unloading before the allocated time will be referred to the Stewards.
- 16.3. Crews that wish to camp may do so, but must be registered with the Event Secretary before Wednesday 12th September. Camping is only for Saturday night. Registration <u>can only</u> be done VIA email to the Event Secretary with FULL names and addresses of all persons camping. All persons staying overnight will be given a wrist band which must be worn at ALL times. Anyone found without a wrist band will be asked to leave the Yarra Glen Racecourse area after 20.30 hrs. Respect for neighbours is asked for in relation to noise.
- 16.4. Security will be provided for the Saturday night so Crews can setup and leave cars etc. at the racecourse. This is for both VRC and VCRS.
- 16.5. There will be food and drinks hot and cold available from 7.30am Sunday 22nd at Rally HQ.

17. FUEL

Fuel is available in Yarra Glen at two service stations both on Melba Highway. 98 RON, Regular unleaded, LPG and Diesel fuel are available.
